Dear parents and families,

Your child took the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR®) earlier this spring, and soon you will receive your child's results. The state assessment is one of many ways to measure student learning. Teachers will use STAAR results along with other information to support your child's learning in the new school year.

Beginning **June 30, 2023** for STAAR end-of-course assessments and **August 16, 2023** for STAAR grades 3–8 assessments, you will be able to access your child's STAAR results by logging into the [Parent Portal](#) on the Seguin ISD website. Then select the link for the Texas Assessment Family Portal. This will take you directly to your child's STAAR results, which will include detailed information for each test question, identifying your child's strengths as well as areas where they may need additional support. Families have shared that seeing which questions their child answered correctly and incorrectly has been beneficial. You will also see easy-to-use resources to help your child focus on the skills they most need help with and can work on at home.

When you meet with your child's teacher in the fall, use this information along with your own observations from the past year and your child's grades to create a [plan](#) to help your child succeed.
