SEGUIN HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS NAMED TEXAS ALL-STATE MUSICIANS



Two Seguin ISD students were recognized as Texas All-State Musicians after a rigorous audition process that completed in January. Sarah Robbins, senior band student, and Abel Davila, senior mariachi student, represented Seguin at the Texas Music Educators Association Conference in San Antonio on February 8-11. These students joined the best high school musicians in Texas as they worked for three days preparing a concert led by renowned conductors. Sarah Robbins performed with the Texas All-State 5A Symphonic Band under the direction of Denis Llinas from the University of Oregon, and Abel Davila performed with the Texas All-State Mariachi led by Steve Carrillo director of Disney's Mariachi Cobre. Less than 3% of students in Texas, who initially audition, are selected as All-State musicians.

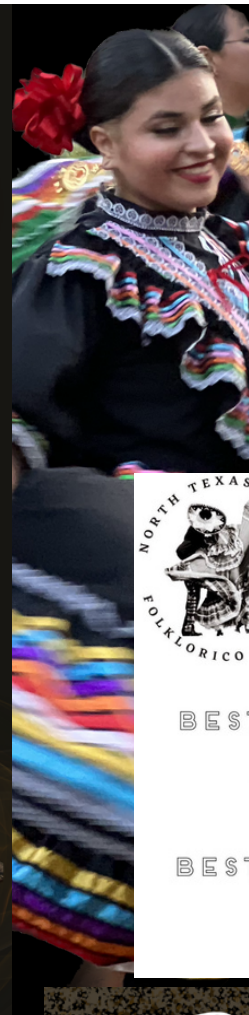
