Greetings Matador Nation,

It's hard to believe that as this edition of Matador Pride goes to press, there are only three months left in the 2022-23 school year.

One of the key initiatives this spring is Bond 2023. We are asking our school community to again consider a proposal for a baseball and softball complex. The election will take place on Saturday, May 6.

Currently, Matador Baseball plays home games at Smokey Joe Field owned by the City of Seguin near the fairgrounds. A new baseball field on the Seguin High School campus would eliminate the need for players and coaches to travel across town to the City's field. By pairing a new baseball field with a new softball field at Seguin High School, both sports could share common facilities at the complex, such as the ticket booth, restrooms and concession.

While the proposed cost for the facility is \$7.5 million, it is important to know that there is no anticipated tax increase should the proposal be approved by voters.

As we finalize early voting and election day dates, times and locations, we will share this information with our school community. The voter registration deadline for the May 6, 2023 election is April 6, 2023. Seguin High School is ready to offer the Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH) for our fall 2023 ninth grade students. This first cohort of students will begin work toward an associate degree in Pharmacy Technology while earning their Seguin High School diploma.

We are proud to offer our students the opportunity to earn an associate degree and high school diploma simultaneously, with no cost to our families.





#### Science!


Seguin High School students who placed third or higher in the local science fair competed in the Alamo Regional Junior Academy Science Fair Jan. 28.


### **Matadors for Habitat**
