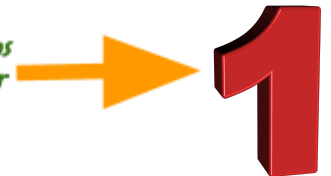
⇒ **IMPORTANT: STUDENTS MAY REGISTER FOR NO MORE THAN 1 CAMP EACH.**

Additional camps may be made available at a later date if registration numbers allow.

Students who are registered for more than 1 camp will be unregistered for any extra sessions beyond their initial registration. Space is limited, and

participation will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Once a camp is full, students may be added to a waiting list. Waiting lists do not count as an extra registration. In the event of an opening in the camp where the student is on the waitlist, parents will be notified and given the opportunity to change their child's registration.

CSI Elementary: Crime Scene Investigations (Incoming Grades 3-5)

Seguin High School, June 21-24, 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

Advanced Archery (Incoming Grades 4-12)

Advanced Archery is open to experienced archers who have previously participated in a Matcamp archery camp over the past two summers who wish to work on more advanced techniques and fundamentals. ***Previous archery experience is required.***

Seguin Esports (Incoming Grades 6-12)

Central Office ITC Lab, June 14-17, 2021, 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

Seguin Eports is a camp that will introduce students to the fast-growing, worldwide phenomenon of esports, or professional gaming. Students will experience all aspects of esports through a variety of activities including a visit to Concordia University's esports program, a live Q&A with Overwatch League caster Seth "Achilios" King, watching professional esports tournaments, and of course playing lots of esports titles!

Ballet Folklórico (Incoming Grades 2-4)

Seguin High School Performing Arts Center, June 28-July 1, 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

Ballet Folklórico is traditional Mexican folk dancing which covers all 32 states in Mexico. Participants will learn traditional, folklóric dances from the different states in Mexico.
