1 Generally, Chapter 573 of the Government Code prohibits you (acting in your capacity as a trustee) from appointing, confirming the appointment of, or voting for the appointment or confirmation of a person that is to be directly or indirectly compensated from public funds if that person is related to you by birth within the third degree or by marriage within the second degree. (The first degree includes: spouse, parent, or child of the trustee or spouse. The second degree includes: brother, sister, grandparent, or grandchild of the trustee or spouse. The third degree includes: great-grandparent, great-grandchild, aunt or uncle who is a sister or brother of a parent of the trustee or spouse, or a niece or nephew who is a child of a brother or sister of the trustee or spouse).

2 Chapter 171 of the Local Government Code defines substantial interest in a business as (1) the ownership of 10 percent or more of the voting stock of the business, or 10 percent or \$15,000 or more of the fair market value of the business; or (2) funds received by the trustee from the business entity exceed 10 percent of that person's gross income for the previous year; or (3) the trustee has a substantial interest in real property if the interest is an equitable or ownership interest with a fair market value of \$2,500 or more. (The trustee is considered to have a substantial interest if a relative within the first degree by consanguinity or affinity has a substantial interest as defined above.) The effect of this provision may be mitigated by the filing of an affidavit with the official record keeper of the Entity stating the nature and extent of his/her interest and by abstaining from discussion and voting on matters related to the purchase of goods and/or services from such businesses.

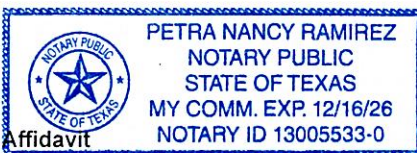

LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICER CONFLICTS DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Section 176.003 of the Local Government Code requires certain local government officers to file this form. A "local government officer" is defined as a member of the governing body of a local governmental entity; a director, superintendent, administrator, president, or other person designated as the executive officer of a local governmental entity; or an agent of a local governmental entity who exercises discretion in the planning, recommending, selecting, or contracting of a vendor.
