Seguin ISD partners with the following institutions of higher education to provide students with opportunities to enroll in dual credit courses. Dual credit courses allow students to earn both high school and college credit concurrently. Students must meet the enrollment requirements outlined by the college. Students should also meet the enrollment criteria by the deadlines provided by the college.



Seguin ISD partners with St. Philip's College to provide traditional dual credit courses and Early College High School courses. Traditional dual credit students can earn up to 42 college credit hours. Students participating in the Early College High School program can earn up to 60+ hrs while pursuing their Associate degree. The college tuition of \$645-\$860 *per* course is waived for students enrolled in St. Philip's College dual credit courses and textbooks are also provided by Seguin ISD.

Seguin ISD will partner with Lamar State College-Orange to provide dual credit courses to P-TECH Academy students. P-TECH Academy students can earn up to 17 hrs while pursuing a level 1 Pharmacy Technology basic certificate. The college tuition of \$645-\$860 *per* course will be waived for students enrolled in Lamar State College -Orange dual credit courses and textbooks are also provided by Seguin ISD.



Seguin ISD partners with Texas Lutheran College to provide students with the opportunity to participate in the Dual Participation Program. This program is designed specifically for 12th grade students who meet the following criteria:

- Rank in the top 10% of the senior class OR
- SAT score of at least 1180 (Combined total of Critical Reading & Math scores ONLY) OR
- ACT score of at least 25 (Composite)

Seniors enrolled in the TLU Dual Participation program can take one course each semester. Tuition and student fees are waived for participating students. Students are responsible for their own transportation and any required textbooks. Students who qualify for this program will be informed during the summer prior to their 12th grade year.
